Principal's Message

Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to the busiest term of the year.

P&C Annual General Meeting – Our P&C AGM and meeting will take place on Monday 28 October. All welcome.

Kickstart to Kindy – Mrs Fogg has collaborated with Connect Family Services to deliver another exciting and jam-packed kindergarten transition program this year. We encourage all families and incoming Kindy students to attend all of these sessions. Connect will be running additional orientation sessions in the school hall. If you plan on enrolling your child, or know of someone who will be enrolling a child in kindergarten 2020, please contact the school office ASAP on 47212158.

Road Safety – Please ensure you utilise the children's crossing. It is critical that we all model safe behaviour on the road to ensure students' safety. There have been a number of near misses, where students have run from their siblings or parents on the way to and from school. A number of concerned members of the public have contacted the school to report these incidents. Please talk to your children about road safety and the importance of crossing at the children's crossing, or the High Street lights.

Out of School Hours Care – A survey was sent home to all families to assess the need for OSHC services in our community. Our before and after school care services are currently shared between three service providers. One of those providers will no longer be servicing our school from December onwards. One of the two remaining services is at capacity and no longer taking enrolments. Please ensure you fill out the form as the school is currently assessing demand and looking at the steps involved in establishing an onsite service. This is a lengthy and involved process and is not guaranteed. The first step, however, is collating responses from the surveys that were sent home yesterday afternoon. Thanks for your assistance.

Staff Development Days – As you are aware, school staff are required to participate in professional learning sessions throughout the year. The first day of the school term in terms 1, 2 and 3 is also set aside for staff development days, as well as the final two days of term 4. This year, staff at Penrith PS will be completing additional professional learning after school hours, which will replace the staff development day on Friday 20 December.

The last day of school for STUDENTS AND STAFF for 2019 will be Wednesday 18 December. The school will be closed for the summer holidays after that time.

School Travel - Term 4 2019

Stay up to date with Opal and ticketing changes for school travel Applications for student travel in 2020 opened on Friday, 11 October 2019.



Students progressing to year 3 and year 7 no longer need to re-apply if they:

- are continuing at the same school
- are residing at the same address
- have not been sent an expiry notification from Transport for NSW.

Where a student meets the new distance eligibility, the system will automatically update their entitlement. If they do not meet the new eligibility, they will receive an expiry notification via email.

Students who have an entitlement approved under a medical condition which is due to expire will receive a notification advising them to re-apply.

Term Bus Pass holders will receive a notification to re-apply.

If students need to update their information or re-apply, they should go online to <u>https://apps.transport.nsw.gov.au/ssts/updateDetails</u>

Applications need to be submitted before 31 December 2019 to ensure student entitlements are updated and their current entitlement/card is not cancelled. If their application is submitted after 31 December 2019, the system will automatically cancel an entitlement/card and a new one will need to be issued.

Students in the Opal network applying for a SSTS or Term Bus Pass entitlement for the first time will receive their card at their nominated postal address. Cards will be mailed out from January 2020.




