### Registration is free

To attend our care, families must register their child first. Registering your child means we have all the correct information we need to best care for them. We have recently received some questions from the community, we heard you and we are here to answer them.

Where is OSHC located? Camp Australia Before and After School care is located in the Hall. Access is via the gate on Doonmore Street & we ask that parents wait at the entrance to the Hall.

My child is in Kindy, will they be picked up from their classrooms? Yes, if your child is booked into After School Care, they will be picked up from their classrooms. Staff will have a separate list of Kindy students booked in that is updated each day to ensure all are picked up.

How do I contact the service? 0402 353 737 is the service mobile.

How do I book in? Please use our Parent Portal mobile app that can be downloaded onto IOS and Android phones, alternatively you can book online at campaustralia.com.au or by phoning our Customer Care team on 1300 105 343. Please note your child MUST be registered prior and only when you receive an email or SMS confirmation has your booking been confirmed.

What will my child be doing at OSHC? There are a range of different activities each day at Before and After School Care, the weekly program ca be viewed on the service information board located at the parent door. Our program includes group games, art and craft, sports and project based activities.
