Principal's Message

Dear Parents and Carers

It is hard to believe another term has come to an end. Friday 1 July will be the last day of term two. Please remember that Monday 18 July is a Staff Development Day and students do not attend school on that day.

Enrolling Now for 2023 – If you have a child commencing kindergarten in 2023, or if you know of anyone commencing school next year, we are taking enrolments now! Our comprehensive Kickstart to Kindy program runs throughout terms three and four.

Payments - We ask that you are vigilant in making payments on time as our office staff are very busy and unable to take payments past the specified cut off dates. Thank you for your support and understanding.

Staffing – We would like to congratulate Mrs Hardie-Grant on her appointment to Kingswood South Public School. Mrs Turner has also secured a relieving position as Assistant Principal at Lapstone Public School for terms three and four. We wish you both every success.

Children's Crossing – We ask you to assist us in ensuring our students' and community's safety by adhering to the speed limit and giving way to pedestrians. Please discuss road safety with your children and the importance of utilising the children's crossing to ensure their safety on the roads. Please wait until the crossing supervisor has returned to the side of the road before crossing the pedestrian crossing.

Kiss and Drop – Stopping for more than two minutes in this area is illegal. Please adhere to all signage. *Illegal parking may result in fines or a loss of demerit points.*

Parent Teacher Meetings – These meetings will take place in week two of term three. Bookings can be made during weeks nine and ten of this term. Information on how to book your meeting will be sent out in the coming weeks.

Parking - Please do not park your car and leave it unattended in the kiss and drop zone on Doonmore Street. This area is patrolled at random and many of our families have received fines for parking and leaving their vehicle. Please refrain from parking in people's driveways also, as this is private property and could be considered trespassing.

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A Word from our Local Police:

ARE YOU SCHOOL SAFE — "Illegal parking around schools endangers children's lives". If you've heard the expression "it's only a matter of time until someone gets hurt" then you'll understand why it is important for EVERYONE to obey the road rules.

School opening and closing hours are busy times for pedestrians and vehicles outside the school. Park safely even if it means walking further to the school gate. Schools provide information in school newsletters and emails to promote safe behaviour and this includes parking legally during drop off and pick up times.

Always take extra care in 40km/h school zones, which operate on gazetted school days. Observe all parking signs. They are planned with children's safety in mind. Illegal parking around schools puts lives at risk. That's why Council and the Police take a 'zero tolerance' approach. Council Rangers, Parking Officers and Police regularly patrol schools across the Penrith LGA.

Parking in a No Parking area - means you can stop to drop off or pick up passengers for a MAXIMUM of 2 MINUTES. You must stay within 3 metres of the vehicle.

Parking in a No Stopping area - means you CANNOT stop in this area for ANY reason.

Parking in a Bus Zone area - means you CANNOT stop or park unless you are driving a bus.

- There are 2 different notices school will send out: push notification (banner and ding) or a notice (visual alert only)
- · You will only receive a push notification if you are not using the app at the time
- If your volume is off you will not hear an alert
- You will see a visual alert if a notice has been posted. You will not hear a ding
- You will only hear a ding if the school sends a push notification.
