Hearing Tests – Hearing Australia – Sound Scouts are conducting hearing assessments at Penrith Public School this week. Please send back your permission notes if you haven't already done so. There is no charge for this service.

Collecting Your Child Early from School - If collecting your child early from school please ring the school office ahead of time and allow extra time for your child to collect their things and make their way to the office.

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Enrolling Now for 2023 – If you have a child commencing kindergarten in 2023, or if you know of anyone commencing school next year, we are taking enrolments now! Our comprehensive Kickstart to Kindy program runs throughout terms three and four.

Kiss and Drop – Stopping for more than two minutes in this area is illegal. Please adhere to all signage. Illegal parking may result in fines or a loss of demerit points. After Hours Entry – School office hours are 8:45am until 3:15pm. The gate on High Street with intercom is unattended and locked outside of these times. If you require entry to the school to collect a child after 3:15pm, please use the Doonmore Street gate (nearest the pedestrian crossing).

Attendance - Education for your child is important and regular attendance at school is essential for your child to achieve their educational best. At Penrith Public School we encourage and support regular attendance of children unless they are unwell. Education in New South Wales is compulsory for all children from the age of six years. It is also important that students arrive at school and class on time. This ensures that students do not miss out on important activities scheduled during prime learning time, helps students learn the importance of punctuality and routine, gives students time to greet their friends before class and reduces classroom disruption. Lateness is recorded as a partial absence and must be explained by parents.

Unwell Children - We remind parents and carers to keep your child at home if they are unwell. If your child appears to be displaying any cold and flu symptoms including runny nose, cough, fever/temperature, nausea, diarrhoea or headache please keep them home to rest even if they test negative to a Rapid Antigen Test. If any child displays symptoms at school, parents and carers may be contacted to collect their child from school. COVID Reporting and Close contacts - If your child has tested positive for COVID, please report the positive result to NSW Health and to the school office. If they are a close contact, they can return to school if they are symptom free and have a negative Rapid Antigen test result.



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Mindfulness

Mindfulness is a means to improve focus and attention whilst reducing stress. It involves focusing on the present moment, concentrating on what's happening and being accepting of what you notice.



Some mindfulness exercises to try:

- Walking mindfulness. Walk slowly, pay attention to the rhythm of your steps and to your surroundings. To up the fun choose animals and try to do their walks!
- Breathing mindfulness. Take one minute to really notice how it feels to breathe. Notice the breath flowing into your nose, down your throat, expanding your belly and reversing. Try using bubbles or pinwheels at the same time.
- Eating mindfulness. At the dinner table take it in turns to use descriptive words for your food: warm, soft, yellow, crunchy, etc. This will help your children try more foods and be more descriptive about what they like or don't like.
- 4. Colouring in: This requires we pay attention only to what is in front of us.



 or a notice (visual alert only)
- You will only receive a push notification if you are not using the app at the time

- You will see a visual alert if a notice has been posted. You will not hear a ding
- You will only hear a ding if the school sends a push notification.


