What is happening?

What are students to wear?

What about party food?

We encourage you to decorate your child's lunch box with Christmas stickers or bows, or perhaps send it in a Christmas gift bag.

**** Some suggestions for suitable party food include:***

- Christmas coloured fruit pieces such as kiwifruits and strawberries, or red and green apples, or grapes.
- Christmas coloured vegetables such as celery, cucumber and capsicum and cherry tomatoes.
- Use a cookie cutter to cut a sandwich into a star shape or Christmas tree
- Fairy bread sandwich where the filling is sprinkles
- Bake some cupcakes and ice with green or red icing
- Include a small amount of lollies
